About the Statistical Digest

The University of the West Indies, St. Augustine Campus, presents The Campus Student Statistical Digest for the academic year 2022/2023. The Digest presents a comprehensive collection of official relevant historical and current data on the student population. These statistics cover a five-year academic period (2018/2019 to 2022/2023) and in certain areas, data for Semester 1 of the current academic year 2023/2024. The report examines student admissions, enrolment, graduation, and departmental and faculty trends. Also highlighted, are trends in student applications, offers and admissions. Of interest, are some key empirical findings emerging from the annual Graduate Tracer Survey of the first-degree graduating class of 2021/2022. The digest serves as the official statistics of The UWI, St. Augustine campus.



Introduction

The University of the West Indies is a five-campus tertiary education institution supported by 17 contributing countries. It offers undergraduate and postgraduate degrees in various fields of study to students from around the region and internationally. The St. Augustine Campus in Trinidad was born in 1960 out of the Imperial College of Tropical Agriculture (ICTA) and typically provides higher education to over 16,000 students. The St. Augustine Campus houses eight faculties: Humanities & Education, Social Sciences, Medical Sciences, Law, Science and Technology, Food and Agriculture and Engineering and Sport. It also hosts a range of research units, centres, and institutes. The UWI, St. Augustine continues to be dedicated to teaching and learning, research, and innovation and to the development of the Caribbean region.

This report is a presentation to the St. Augustine Campus Council for the academic year 2022/2023. The statistical information presented provides quantitative measures and utilises descriptive statistics to illustrate current and historical data on student participation and performance for the period 2018/2019 to 2022/2023. It also provides a snapshot of student statistics for Semester 1 of the current academic year, 2023/2024. This report delivers information on the following areas:

- a. **Student statistics over a five-year period in respect of Student Applications, Admissions, Enrolment and Graduation**
- b. **Faculty statistical comparisons**
- c. **A demographic profile of students by nationality, age and sex**
- d. **Highlights obtained from the annual Graduate Tracer survey**
- e. **Student enrolment at the programme level.**

This document was produced with Enrolment data and Graduation data that were generated on November 2nd, 2023. As such, any updates made to data subsequent to the aforementioned dates would not be reflected in the statistics presented.

Definitions of Key Terms and Concepts

Acceptance Rate	The percentage of applicants who received official offers from the St. Augustine Campus.
Applications	The number of submitted applications from individuals (head count).
Contributing Countries	Countries included in the UWI 12 + 1 as well as Barbados, Jamaica and Trinidad & Tobago.
Evening	Students registered in Certificate/Diploma or Degree programmes offered specifically in the Evening University.
Bachelor's Degree First Year Retention	The percentage of students from a specific entry cohort who re-enrol for a second year of study.
Full-Time	Registered students who carry the complete load of course credits associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year.
Nationals	Students whose country of nationality is Trinidad & Tobago.
New Admissions	Registered students who are new first-time entrants and new first-time transfers to the University.
No College Designated	Students who are enrolled in Summer Programmes who are registered with a particular faculty.
Non-Contributing Countries	All nations other than the UWI 12 + 1, Barbados, Jamaica or Trinidad & Tobago.
Not Identifiable (NI)	No data available in the data repository.
Offers	The number of applicants (head count) given institutional acceptance (offers).
Off Campus	Students enrolled in programmes that are administered at UWI-affiliated institutions and are not located in the host country, that is Trinidad & Tobago.
On Campus	On Campus Students who attend classes on the St. Augustine or Mt. Hope campuses and are in pursuit of a degree, certificate, or diploma programme.
On-Time Graduation	The number of students that completed their degree programme within the time frame allotted by the University.
Other Students	Students enrolled in undeclared courses, summer programmes , professional continuing education and pre-university programmes.
Part -time	Registered students who carry less than the complete load of courses associated with their university programme for that semester/academic year.
Postgraduate (PG)	Students enrolled in Higher Degree programmes at the St. Augustine Campus which lead to the acquisition of a qualification beyond a first degree such as the PG Diploma, Taught Master, Master of Philosophy, Doctorate etc.
Pre-University Students	Students enrolled in the Pre-Science, Pre-Health and Pre-Engineering programmes.
Programme	The course of study for which the student has been admitted into the University. This pertains to Certificates, Diplomas, Undergraduate (BSc, BA, BEd), Postgraduate Diplomas and Higher Degrees (MA, MSc, MPhil, PhD, etc.).
Qualifying	A student reading for courses to qualify for entry to a postgraduate programme.
Registration/Enrolment	The process by which students, upon acceptance into a given faculty and programme at the University, give written notification of the courses which they wish to pursue during the current semester/academic year. Various aspects of the registration data are represented in the tables. For this document, this includes both on and off campus students. Students categorised as Other (see definition above) are represented in separate tables.
Specially Admitted/ Specially Admitted (Stand Alone)	Persons may register to read a course or courses within the UWI, without being registered in an Undergraduate or Postgraduate degree programme. These persons are considered for entry as "Specially Admitted students". Under the University's rules, such persons may read up to total of 24 credits in this category or registration. A maximum of nine (9) relevant credits obtained through special admission can be counted towards UWI certification and Graduate Diplomas and Degrees of The UWI.
Student Session	Students enrolled in a full-time, part-time, evening, or summer basis.
Summer	Students enrolled to pursue courses during the summer semester, which occurs, from June to July of the academic year.
Undergraduate (UG)	Students enrolled at the St. Augustine Campus in programmes, which lead to the award of a Certificate, UG Diploma or First Degree.
Undeclared	At UWI 'Undeclared' is a level, in addition to UG, PG, Cert., etc. used to differentiate students in a non-degree or certificate programme, such as the Pre-Science (N1) programme or Pre-Health Professions Programme (PHPP).
Yield Rate	The percentage of students that, upon receipt of an offer, choose to be enrolled at the St. Augustine Campus. The rate is commonly used as a measure of selectivity indicating interest in a particular institution.

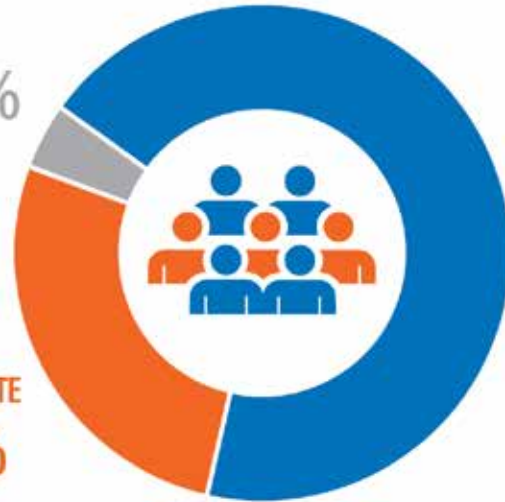

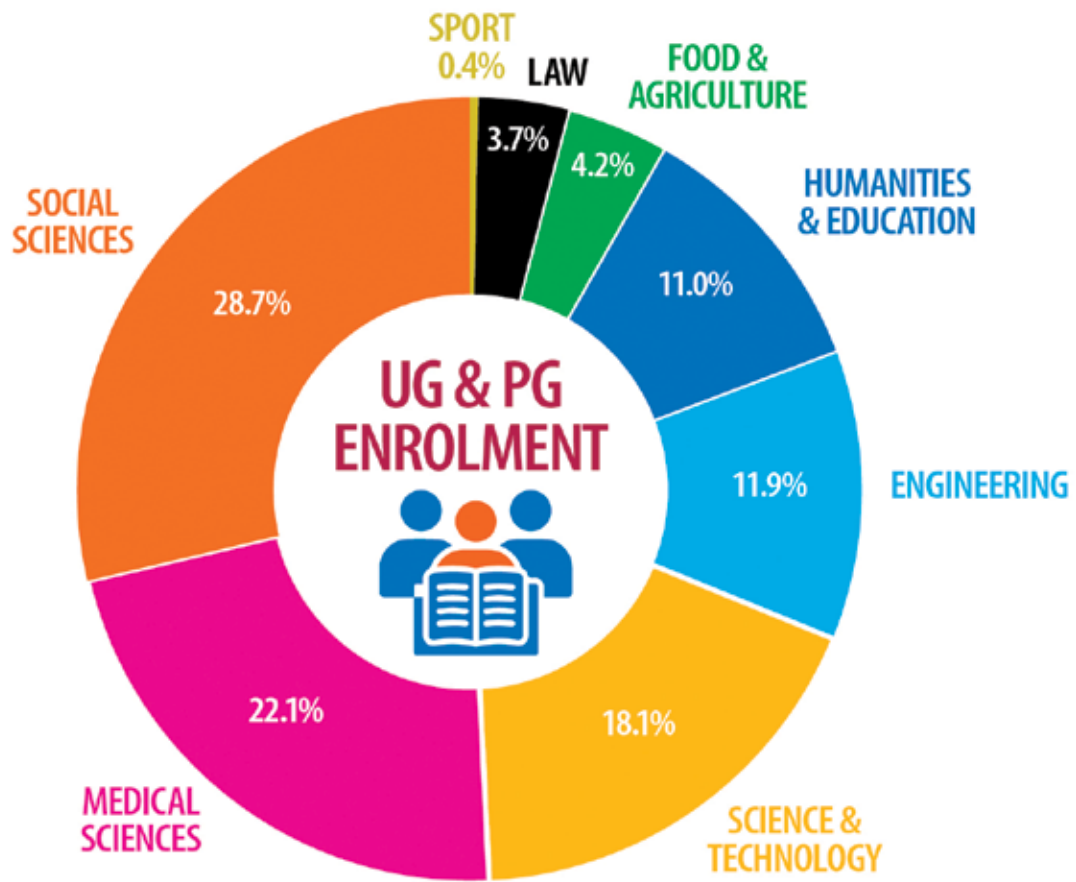

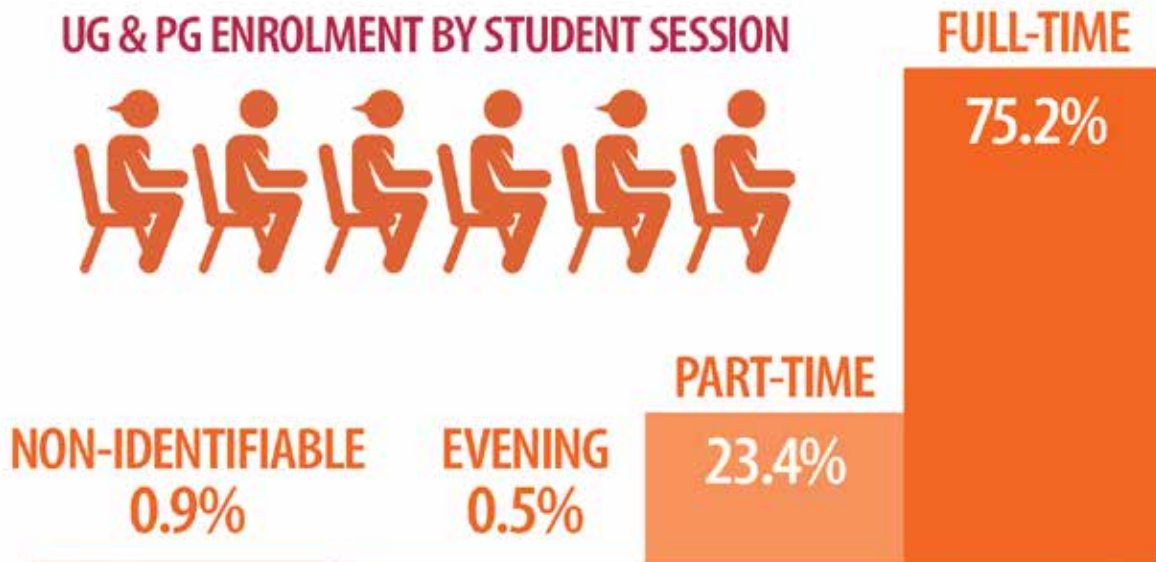

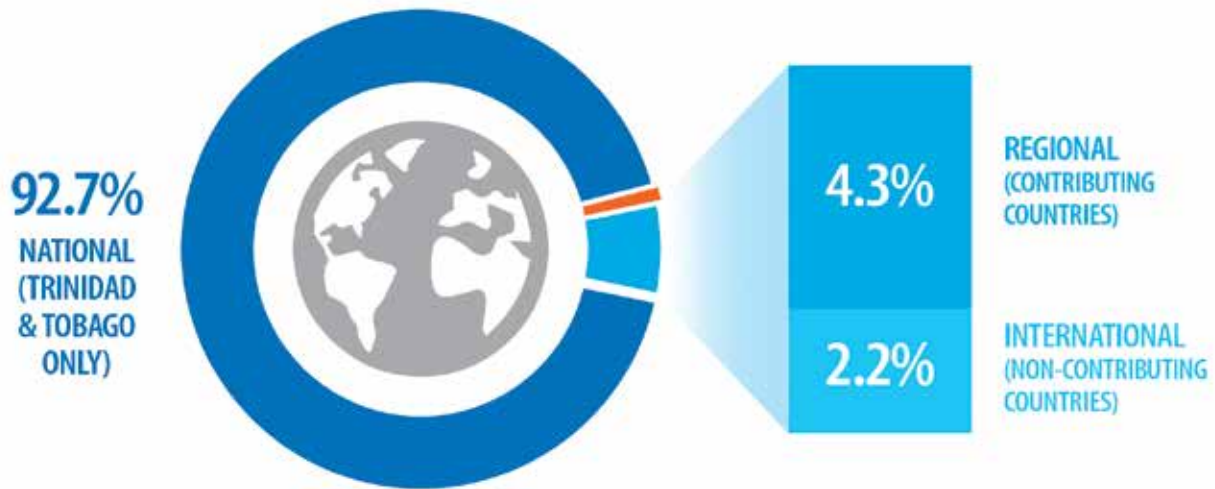




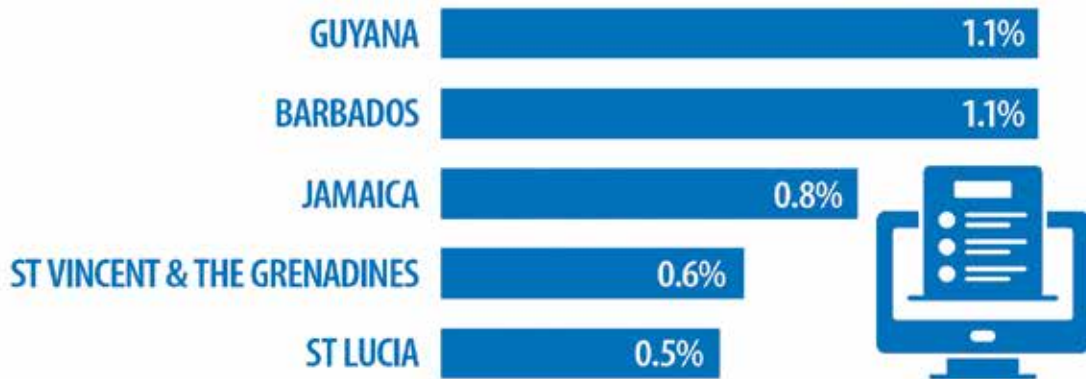

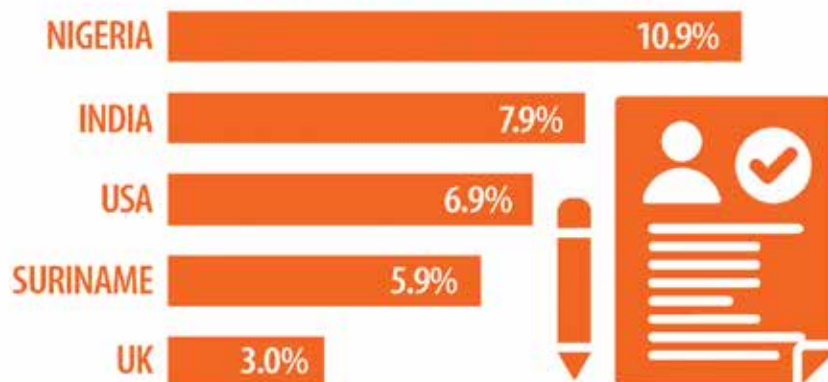
UG & PG ENROLMENT BY NATIONALITY



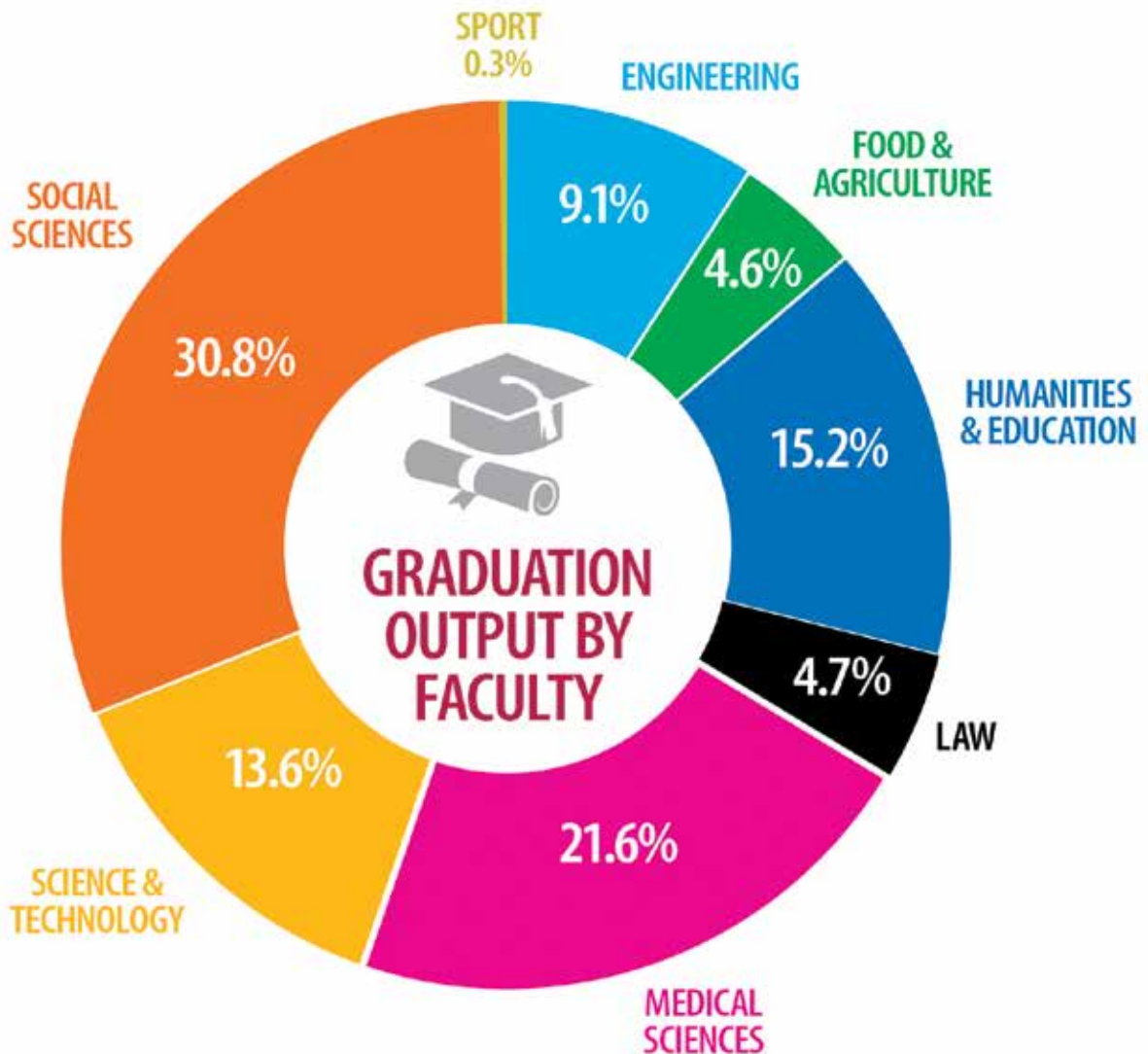
HIGHEST ENROLMENT AMONG REGIONAL (CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES)



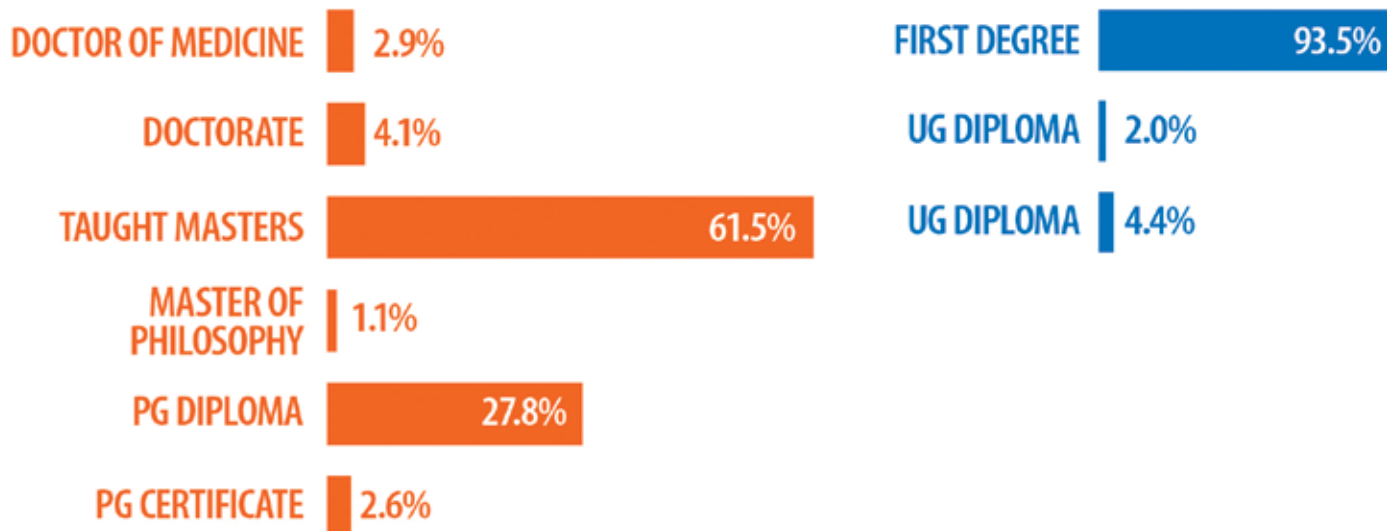
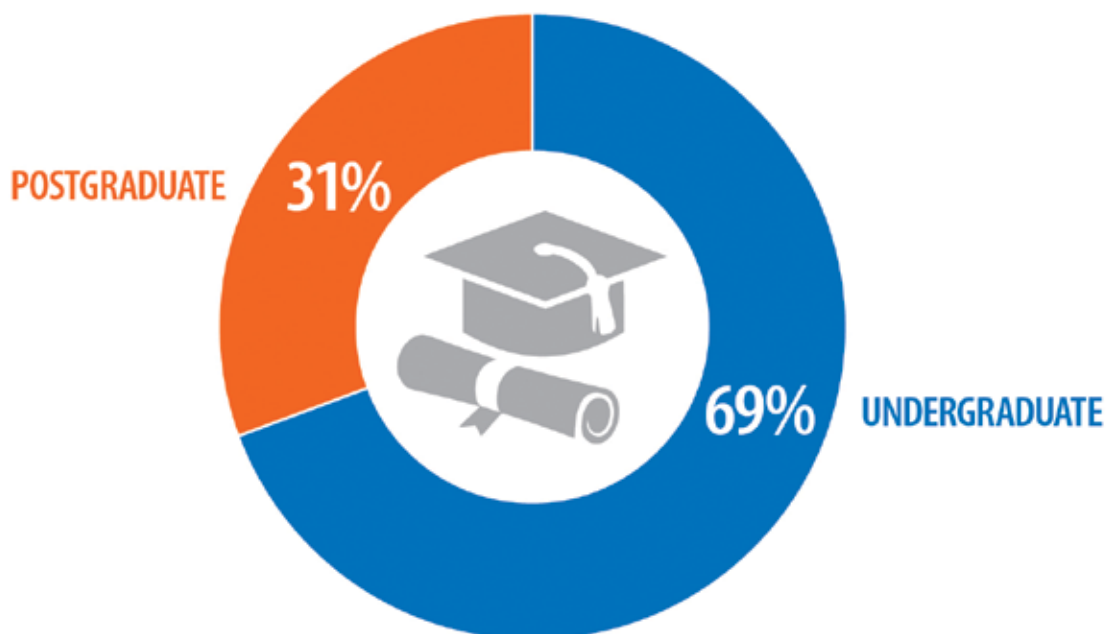
HIGHEST ENROLMENT AMONG INTERNATIONAL (NON-CONTRIBUTING COUNTRIES)

Section 1– Trends in the Number of Applications, Offers and New Admissions

Figure 1.1 below illustrates undergraduate and postgraduate trends for applications, offers and new admissions over a ten-year period. In 2016/2017 applications peaked at 12,174 but since then applications have declined to 7744 in 2023/2024 representing a 36.4% decline. Offers have also trended downwards since 2016/2017 from 8624 to 5405 representing a 37.3% decline. From 2016/2017 to 2021/2022, new admissions declined significantly by 36.9%. However, there has been indications of an upward trend over the past two (2) years.

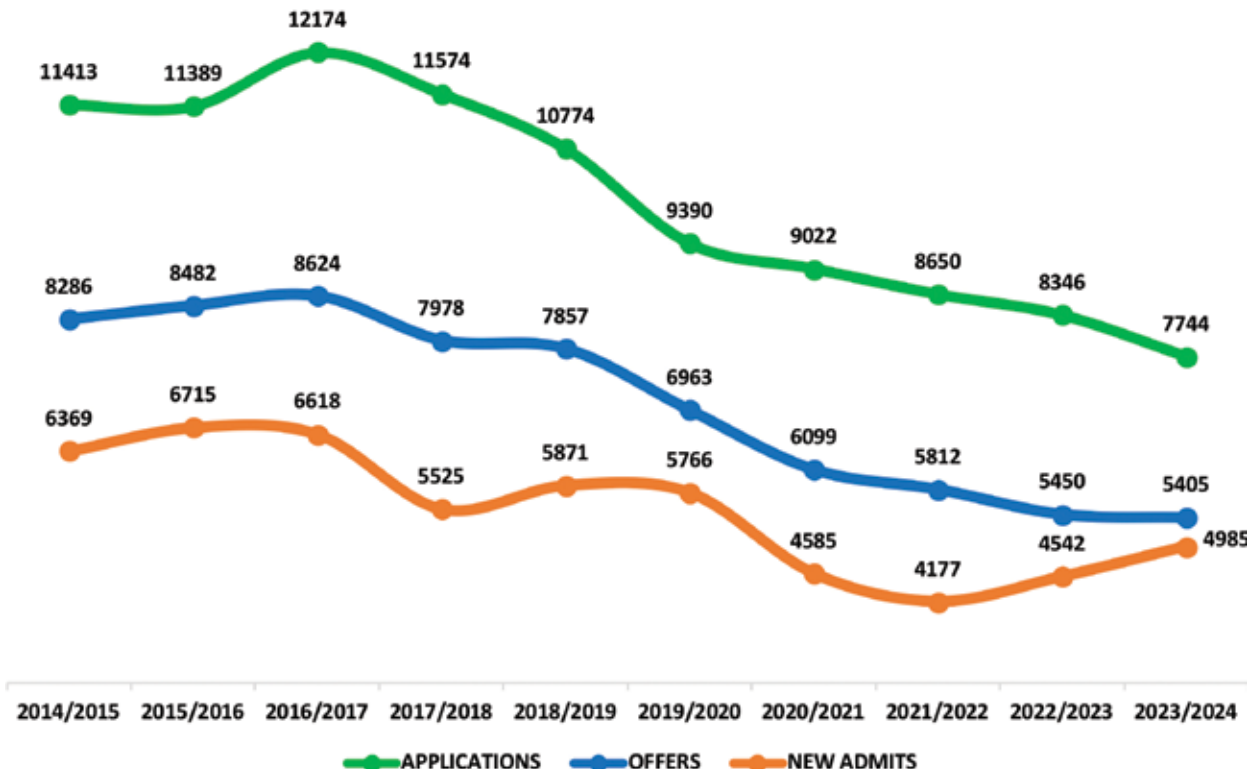

Figure 1.2 shows fluctuating trends in acceptance rates (Offers/Applications) averaging at 70% over the past ten (10) years. There has been a notable decline since 2020/2021 where acceptance rates hovered between 65% and 70% for each year.

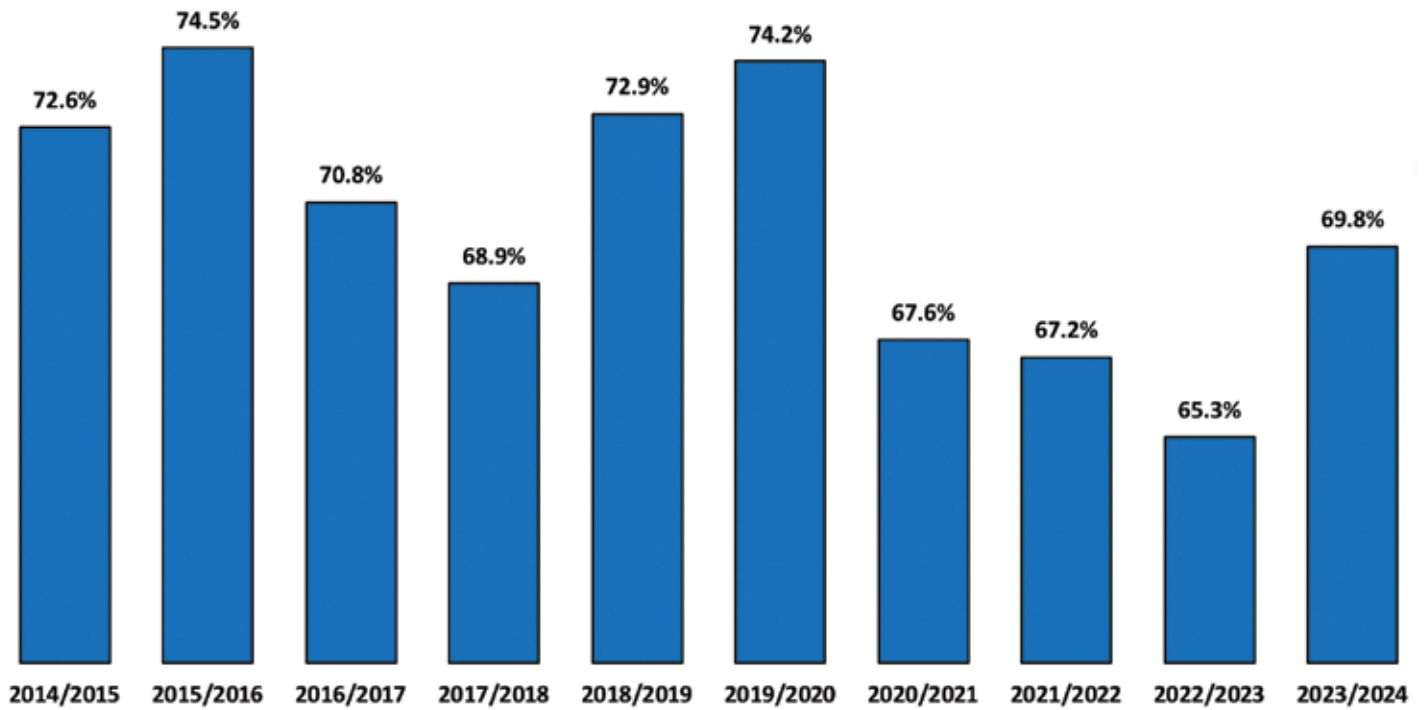
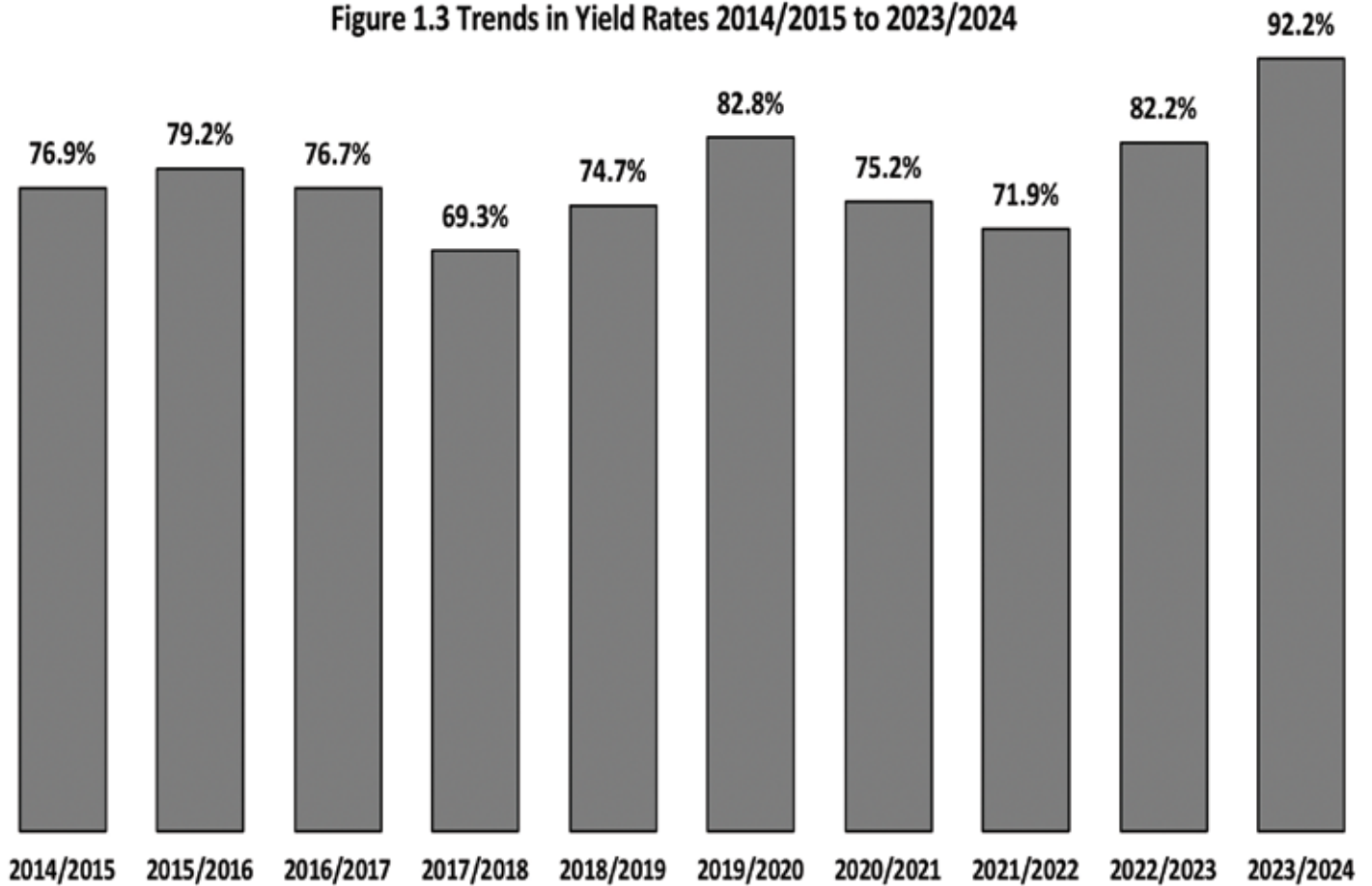


Figure 1.3 Trends in Yield Rates 2014/2015 to 2023/2024

Figure 1.3 shows a consistent trend in Yield rates (new admissions/offers), with an average of 79.3% over the ten (10) year period. However, a steady increase of approximately 10% has been observed each year since 2021/2022. This represents an increase in yield rates of 20% between 2021/2022 and 2023/2024.

Figure 1.2 Trends in Acceptance Rates 2014/2015 to 2023/2024

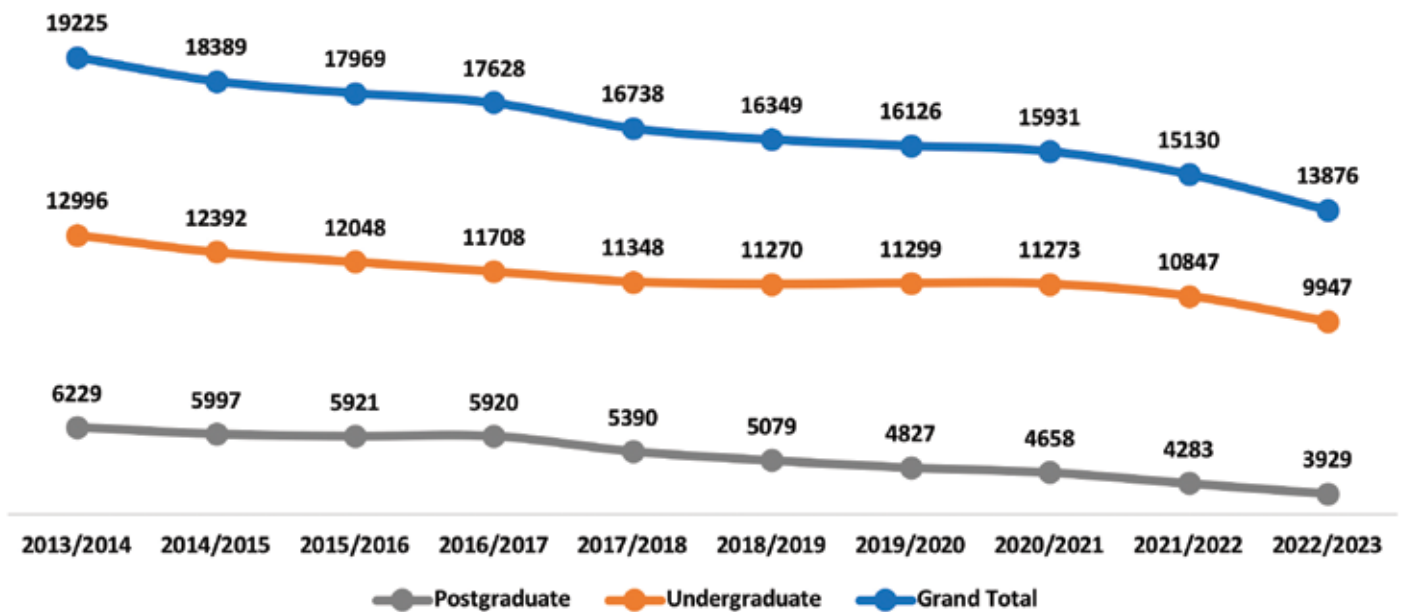
Section 2 – Total Enrolment Trends for UG and PG Students 2018/2019 to 2022/2023

Student enrolment is representative of new and continuing students at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels in the eight (8) faculties of Engineering, Food and Agriculture, Humanities and Education, Law, Medical Sciences, Science and Technology, Social Sciences and Sport.

In 2022/2023, the undergraduate and postgraduate population constituted 68.6% and 27.1% respectively of total enrolment. A review of current UG and PG enrolment trends demonstrated a continuous decline of 27.8% when compared to 2013/2014. This represented an average annual decline of 4% over the ten-year period.

In particular, there has been a decline in student enrolment between the period 2016/2017 to 2022/2023 (See Figure 2.1). This can be attributed to the progressive decline in postgraduate enrolment of 33.5% since the period 2016/2017. For the same period, undergraduate enrolment has also been on the decline but less so by 15.0% overall.

In terms of overall trends in the demographic profile of the total student population, for the academic year 2022/2023, approximately 62.3% are female and 37.6% are male with a significant proportion of the undergraduate student population within the age cohort of 18 – 24 years. Over the five (5) year period, at the undergraduate level, the median age of new entrants was 20 with this group accounting for 89.1% of the undergraduate new admissions in 2022/2023. For postgraduate new admissions, the median age was 34 with this grouping making up 81.6% of the new entrants at this level

The trend in the age distribution for the academic year 2022/2023 indicates a lesser proportion of students entering postgraduate studies at the youngest age bracket of 0 to 24 by 18% and at the undergraduate level at least 10% more students entered at an older age bracket of between 25 to 34.

In terms of nationality, 92.3% of the student population are nationals of Trinidad & Tobago, 4.2% were from the contributing countries, while those from non-contributing countries represented approximately 2%.

In Table 3.1 below, the figure representing Total Enrolment includes all undergraduate, postgraduate and other students. All other tables in this section will show analysis for the Undergraduate and Postgraduate student populations only.

Figure 3.1: Postgraduate Enrolment by Age Group at Entry 2018/2019 to 2022/2023

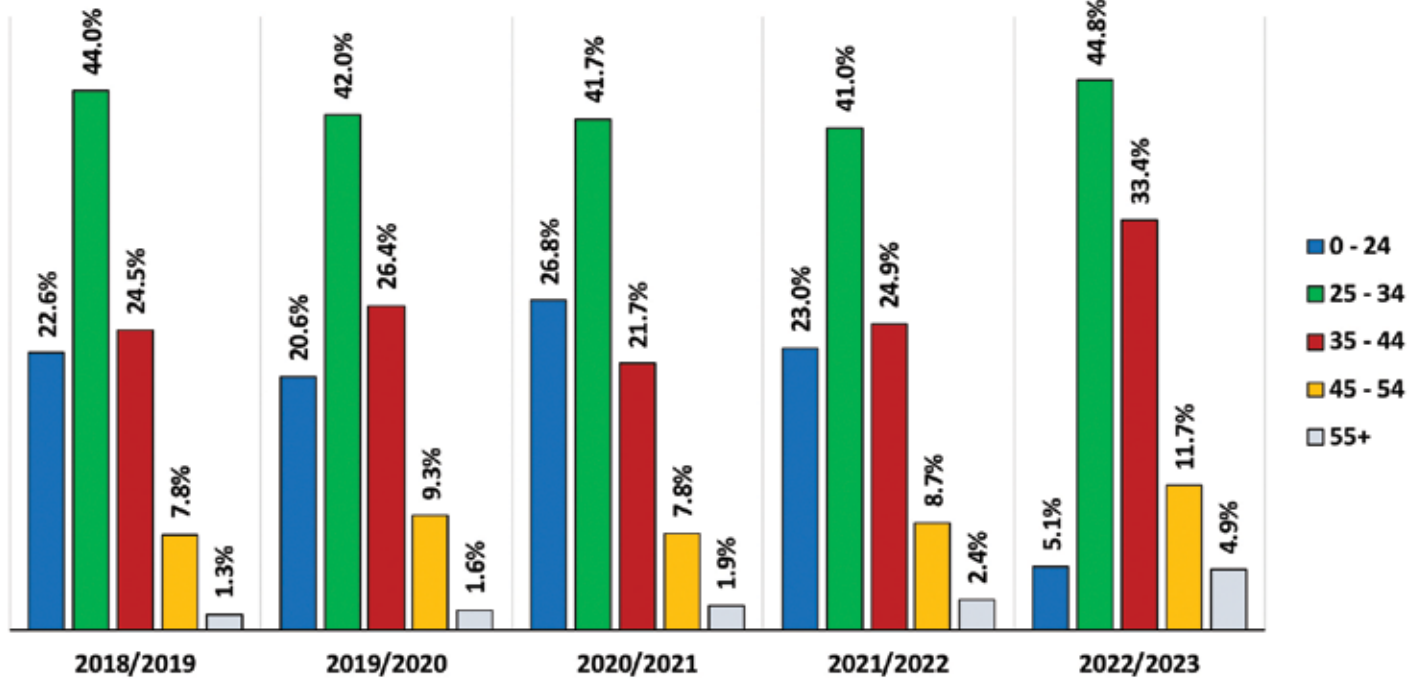
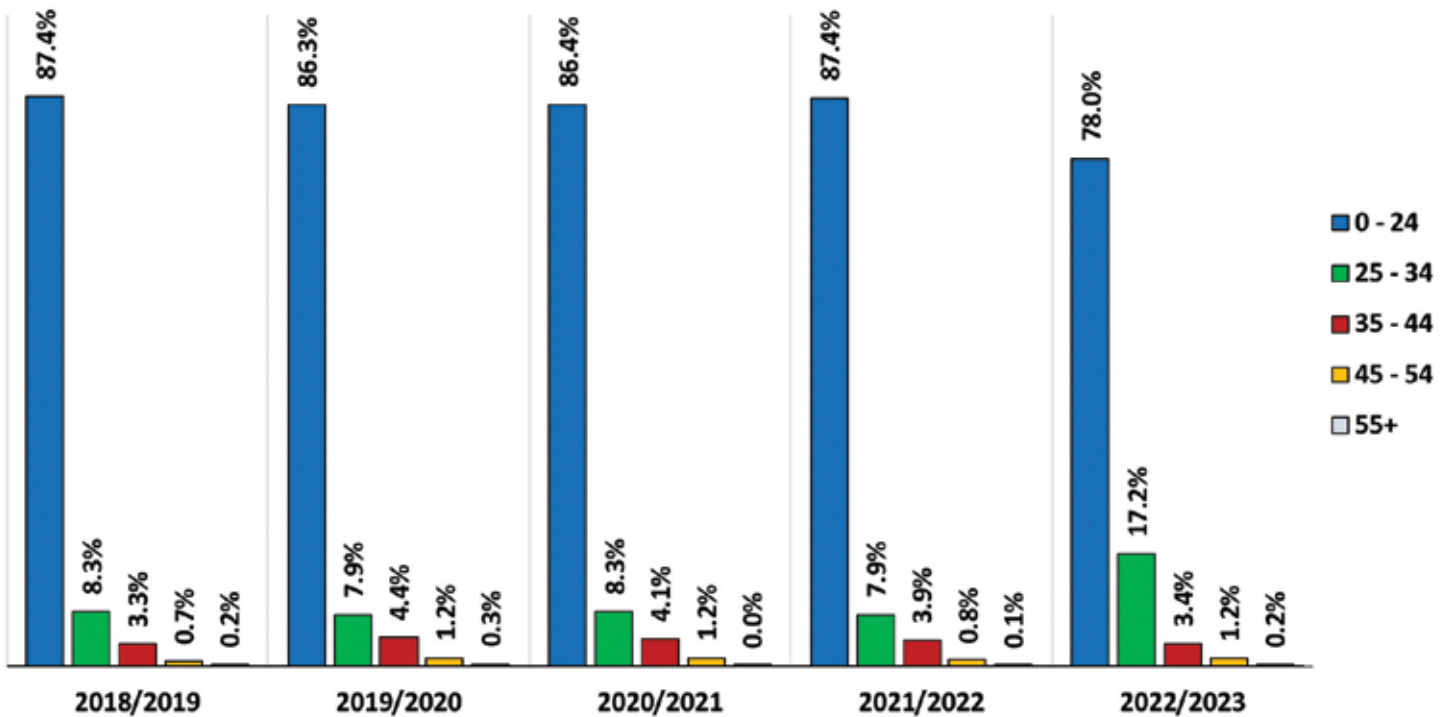


Figure 3.2: Undergraduate Enrolment by Age Group at Entry 2018/2019 to 2022/2023

Figure 3.3: Postgraduate Enrolment by Nationality 2018/2019 to 2022/2023

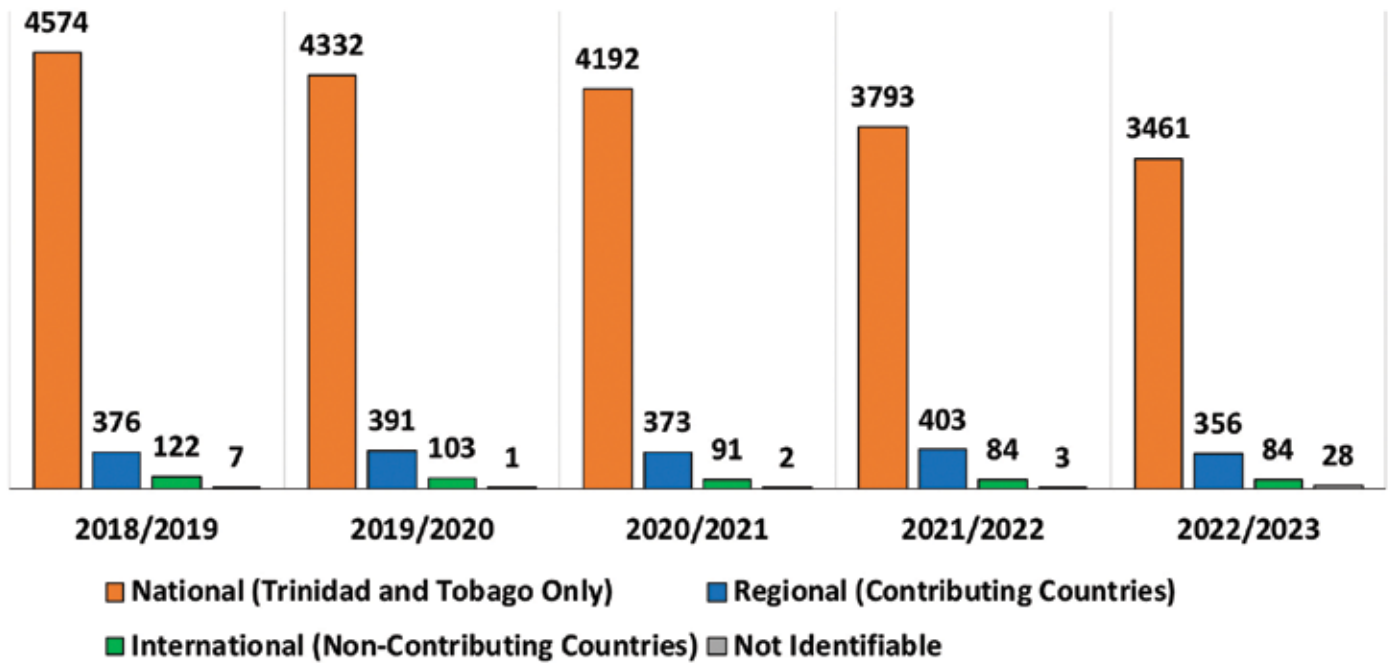
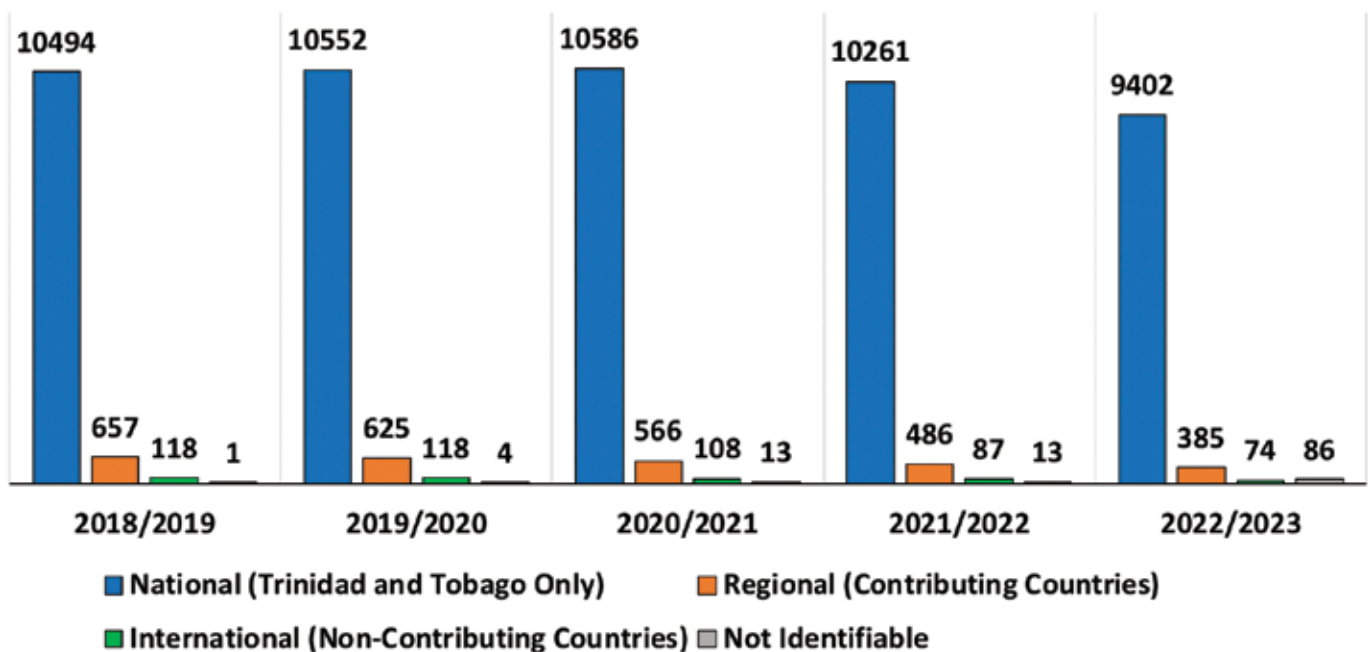


Figure 3.4: Undergraduate Enrolment by Nationality 2018/2019 to 2022/2023

Section 4 – Undergraduate and Postgraduate Faculty Trends 2018/2019 to 2022/2023

The Faculty of Social Sciences continued to be the largest faculty, accounting for 28.7% the UG & PG student population. The faculties which followed included Medical Sciences and Science & Technology at 22.1 % and 18.1% respectively. In the academic year 2022/2023, the highest proportion of Postgraduate enrolment was in the Faculty of Social Sciences (35%) including those enrolled in the Arthur Lok Jack Global School of Business. The Faculty of Humanities and Education had the second highest postgraduate enrolment (19.9%), followed by Engineering (14.7 %). Overall enrolment trends indicated that the faculties of Food and Agriculture, Humanities and Education have experienced the most significant decline of 37.8% and 27.1% respectively, over the 5-year period. However, at the postgraduate level Engineering and Social Sciences experienced the highest decline in enrolment of 35.9% and 34.3% respectively.

Figure 4.1: Postgraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2018/2019 to 2022/2023

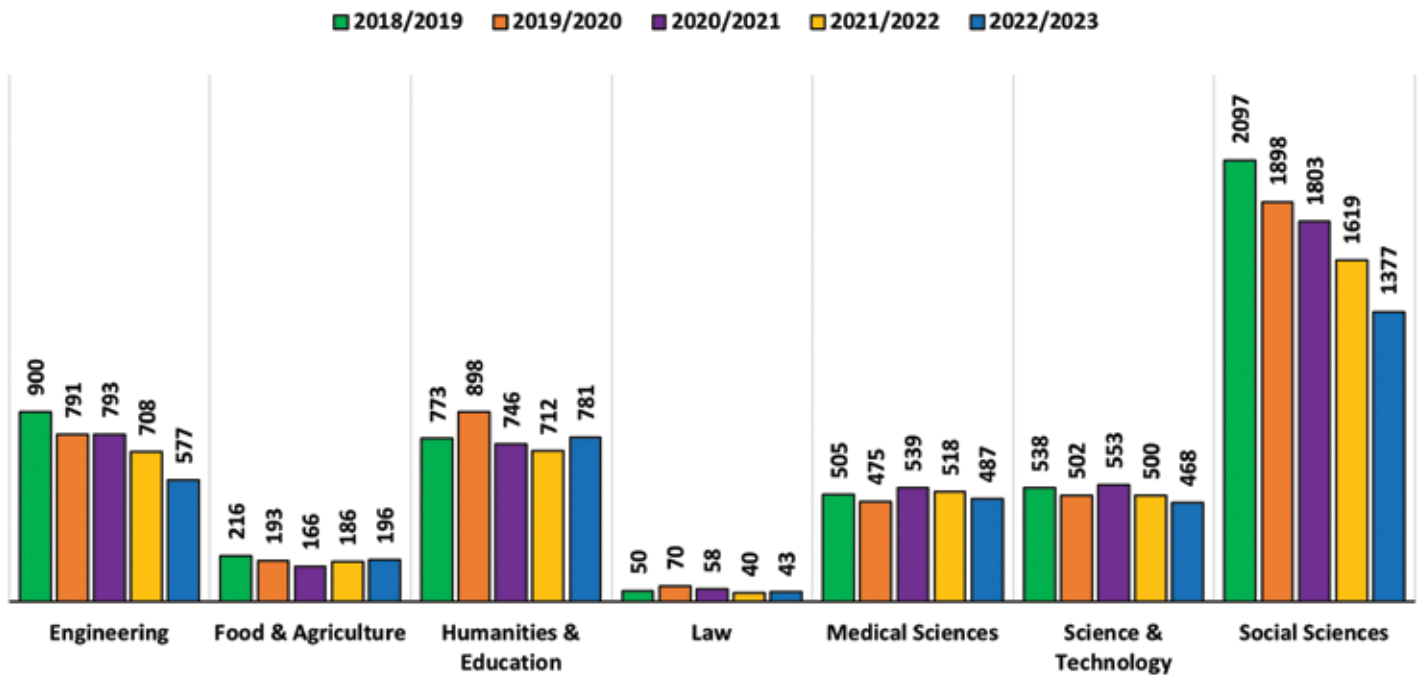
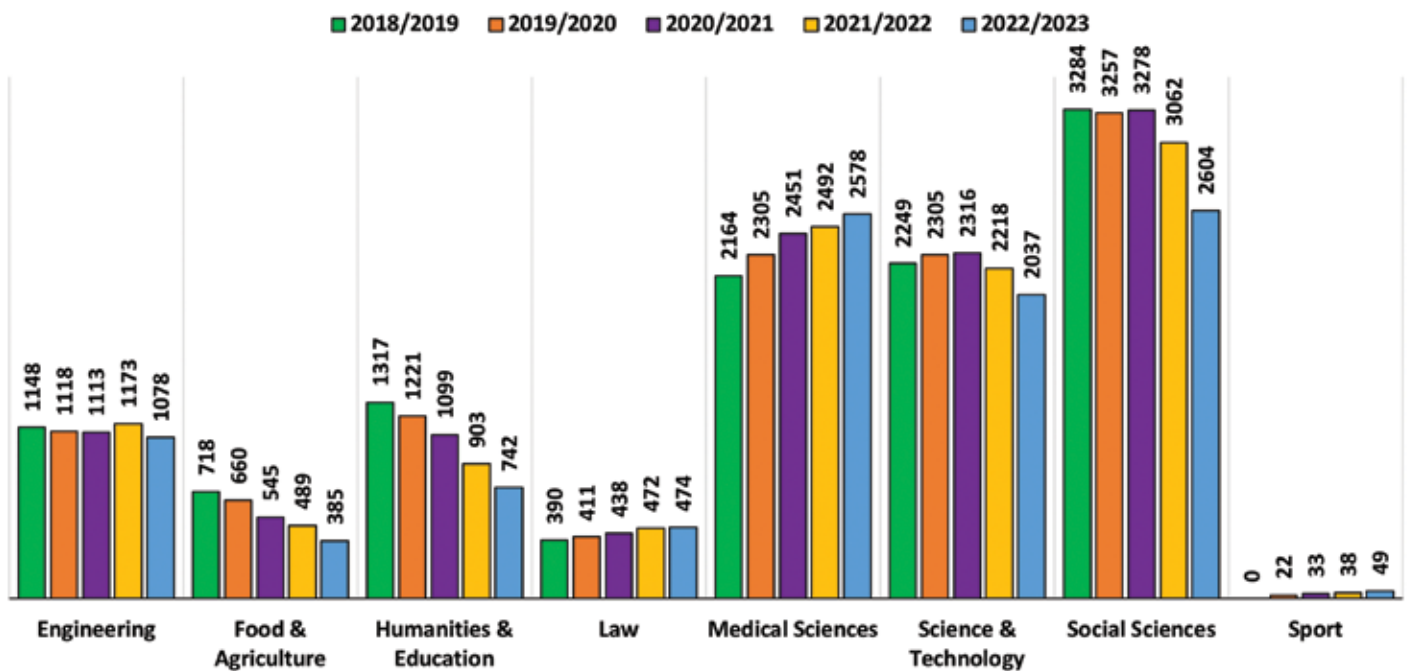


Figure 4.2: Undergraduate Enrolment by Faculty 2018/2019 to 2022/2023

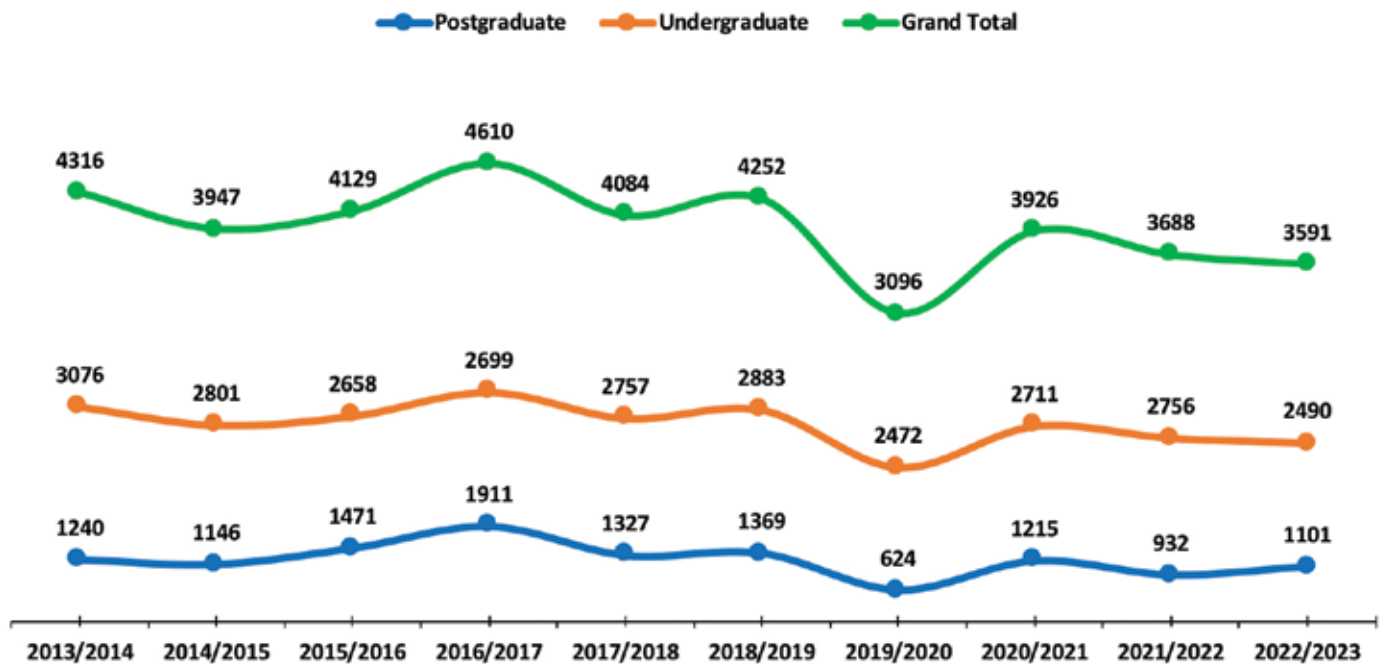
This section provides data on graduate output in respect of demographics, faculty, degree honours and graduate throughput. A total of 3591 persons graduated in 2022/2023 with 69.3 % and 30.6% at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels respectively. This represented a decline in the number of graduates when compared to 3688 in 2021/2022.

Of the degrees awarded in 2022/2023, 64.8 % were first degree graduates and 21.3% were higher degree graduates. This represented a decrease of approximately 4% in the proportion of first degrees, when compared to 2021/2022.

The highest number of degrees were awarded at the undergraduate level in the following programmes: Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery, Bachelor of Medical Sciences, Bachelor of Nursing, Bachelor of Law and BSc Management Studies. At the postgraduate level, graduates were mainly awarded taught masters degrees in the following programmes: MBA Business Administration, MSc Management Studies, MSc Project Management, MSc Renewable Energy Technology and MSc Strategic Leadership & Management.

Information extracted from the annual Graduate Tracer Survey of first-degree graduates of 2021/2022 are presented below in Figures 5.1 to 5.5. The feedback received from the graduates are captured one-year post graduation and presents an indication of the sectors of their employment, the main areas of economic activity of their employers, the time taken to find employment and the salary ranges earned.

Figure 5.2: Respondents by Sector of Employment 2021/2022

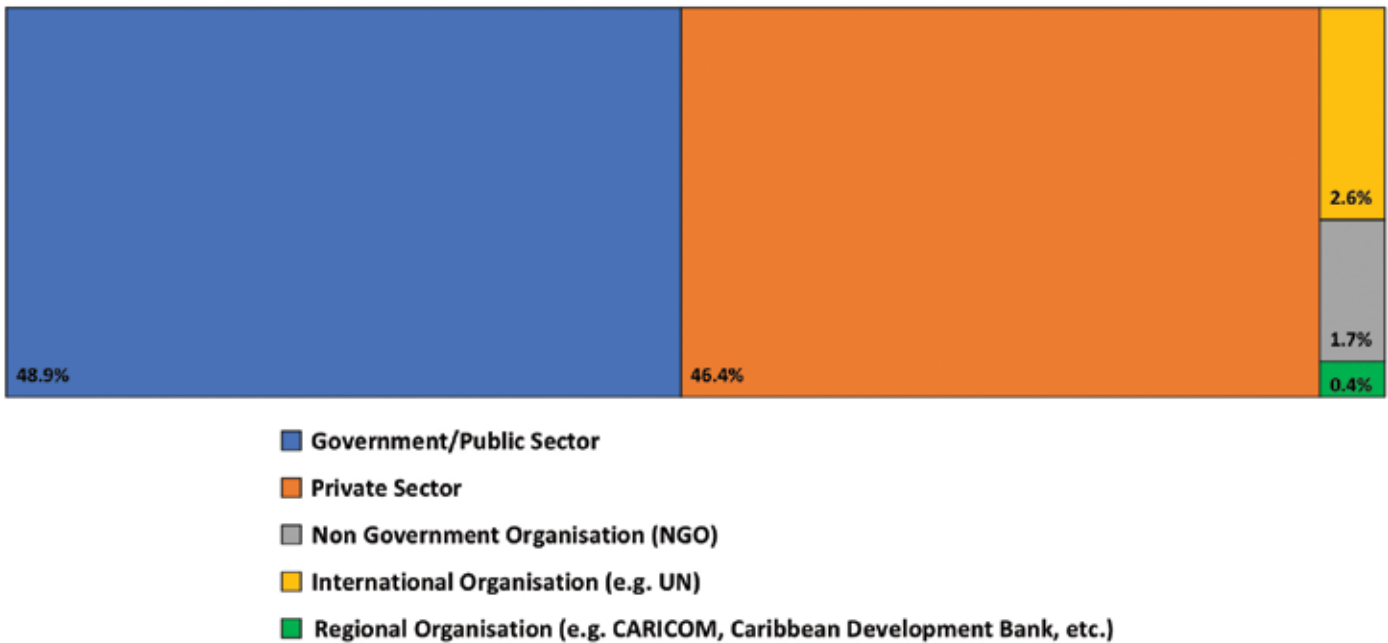
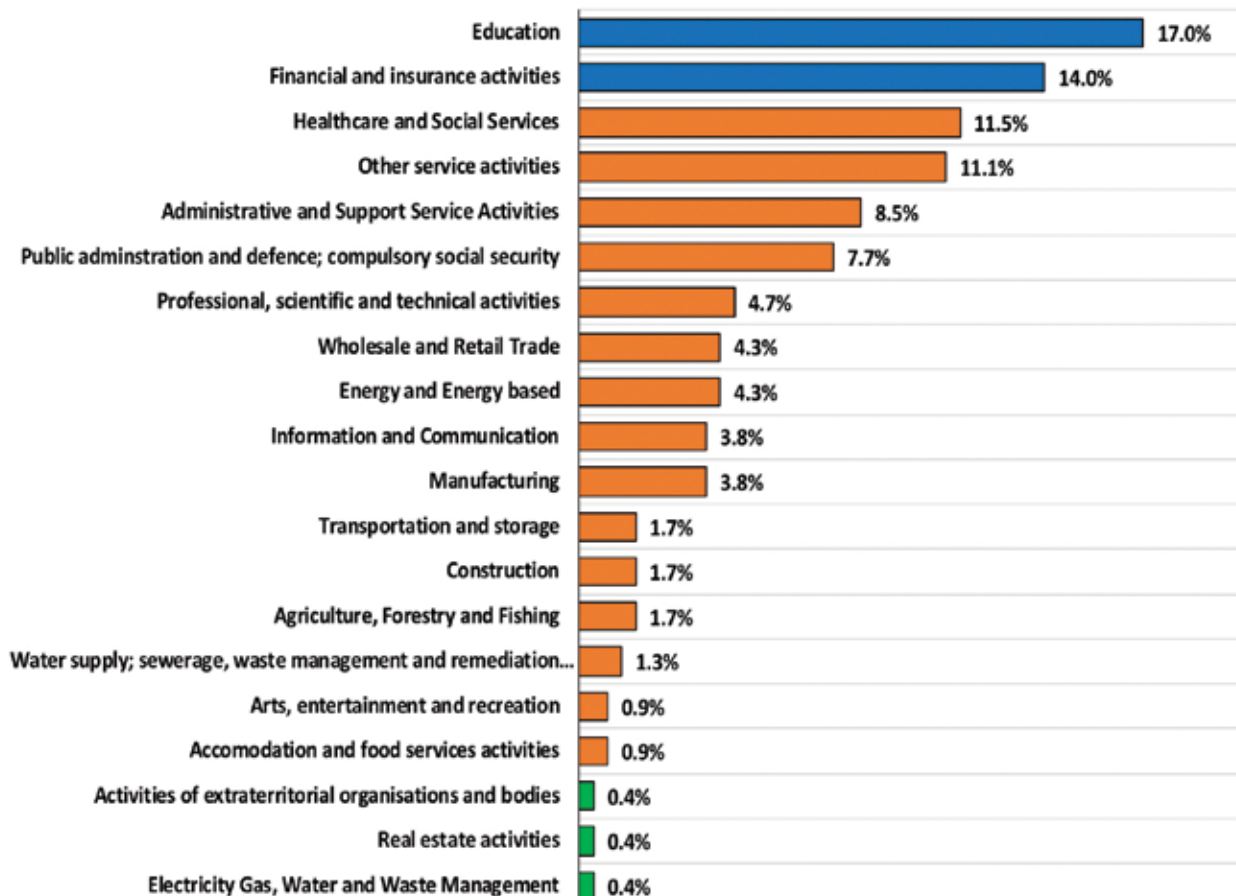


Figure 5.3: Respondents' by Employers' Areas of Economic Activity 2021/2022

Figure 5.4: Respondents' Mean Time Take to Find Employment (In Months) 2021/2022

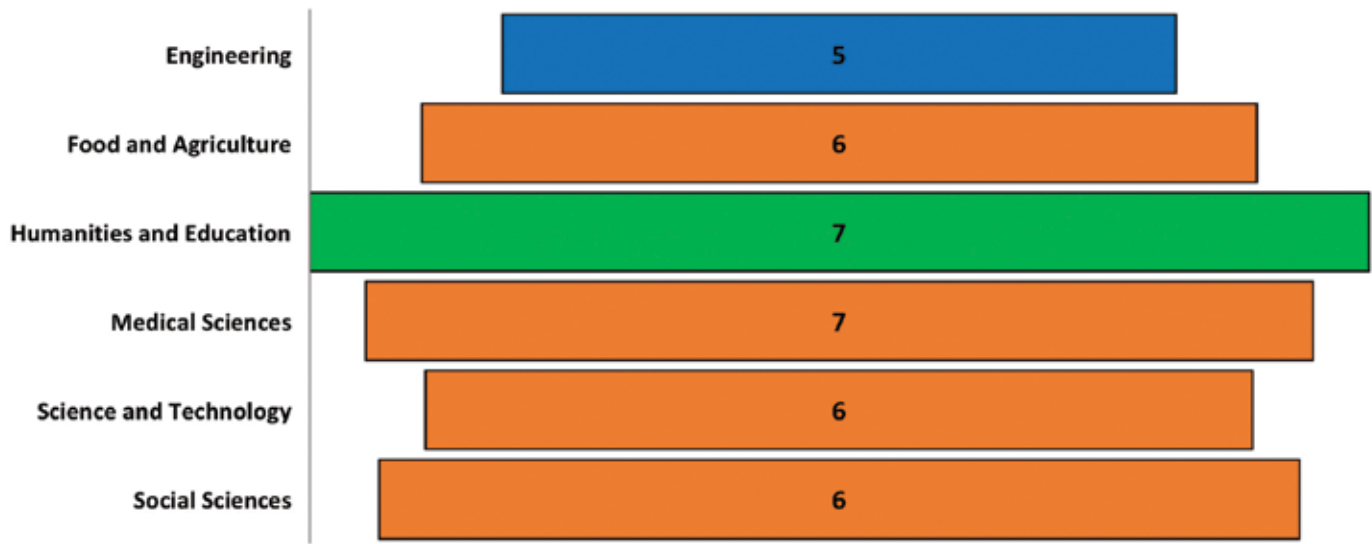
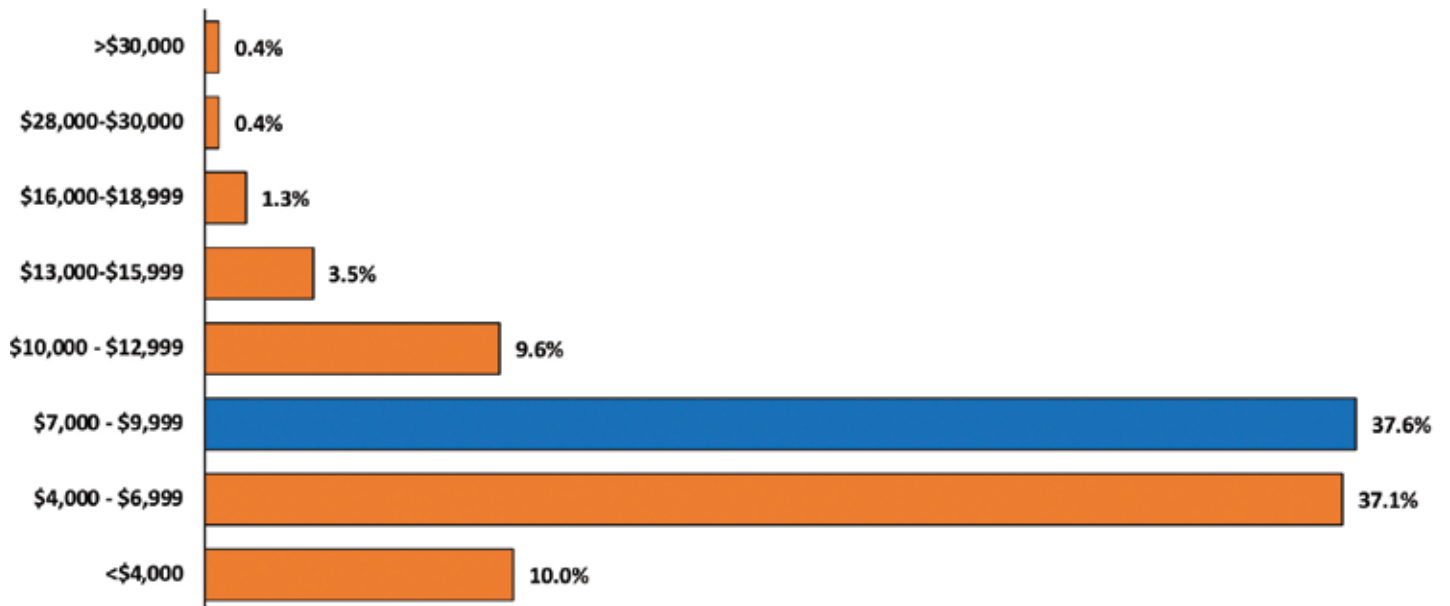


Figure 5.5: Respondents' Salary Range (TT\$) for 2021/2022
